

Privacy Policy

Introduction

In this privacy policy us, we, our or Astron means Astron Corporation Limited ARBN 154 924 553 and its related bodies corporate.

This Privacy Policy sets out:

- 1. The kind of information that we collect and hold;
- 2. How this information is collected, held and disclosed;
- 3. The purposes for which this information is collected, held, used and disclosed;
- 4. How you may access personal information we hold and update such information;
- 5. How you may contact us should you have any concerns about personal information we hold.

This policy may be updated from time to time to ensure compliance with new or amended laws, as a result of new technology or to keep up with changes in our operations.

Collection of personal information

We may collect your personal information including (but not limited to) name, contact details (such as address, email, phone number) and when you:

- 1. make enquiries including about our products and services;
- 2. make enquiries regarding community engagement activity;
- 3. make an application for employment; or
- 4. register on our website.

You are not obliged to provide us your personal information. However, failure to do so may mean that we are unable to provide you services or respond to your inquiries.

We may use tracking technologies, such as cookies or web beacons, to make the use of our website and services as convenient as possible. Cookies are pieces of information that a website transfers to a computer's hard disk for record keeping purposes. Most web browsers are set to accept tracking technologies such as cookies or web beacons. These tracking technologies do not themselves personally identify users and the information collected does not constitute personal information. Consequently, the Australian Privacy Principles do not apply to the tracking technologies. These tracking technologies allow us to monitor the items an individual may want to purchase as they move through the website, and to record how many people are using the different parts of our website. It is possible to set your browser to refuse tracking technologies such as cookies or web beacons, however, this may limit your use of our website.

Use of your personal information

Your personal information will be used for the following purposes:

- 1. to fulfil obligations under any contract for the supply of services and/or any other contract between us and you;
- 2. to provide you with information about community engagement and our projects;
- 3. to consider job applications;
- 4. to render services related to our business;
- 5. to provide you with information about our products, services and special offers;
- 6. to send you regular communications;
- 7. to obtain your opinions or comments about products and services; and
- 8. to record statistical data for marketing analysis.

Disclosure of your personal information

We may disclose your personal information to other Astron group companies in Australia and in Hong Kong. Your personal information may also be disclosed to a third party:

- 1. who is engaged by us to provide services on our behalf (such as operating our website, conducting market research, recording statistical data or recruitment);
- 2. who is our supplier for your services to be supplied;
- 3. who is our agent or partner (including in relation to recruitment);
- 4. who may purchase our business;
- 5. in order to investigate your activity if we suspect you have breached our terms and conditions or have been engaged in other unlawful activity; or
- 6. as permitted or required by law.

We take steps to ensure that any third party to whom we disclose your personal information will comply with the Australian Privacy Principles.

You consent to our disclosure of your personal information as set out above.

Accessing and updating your personal information and opting out.

You can access and update the personal information that we hold about you, request that your personal information be removed from our database or inform us that you do not wish to receive communications from us by contacting us by email at info@astronlimited.com. Please allow 14 days for this request to be processed.

If you request your personal information be deleted from our databases, we shall take all reasonable steps to do so except where the information is required for legal reasons. Deletion of your personal information means that we may be unable to sell products directly or provide certain services including any relevant services to you.

Storage and security of personal information

We will endeavour to take all reasonable steps to keep secure any personal information recorded and to keep this information accurate and up to date. Personal information is stored on secure servers in digital format or in locked areas if in hardcopy format. However, security of communications over the internet cannot be guaranteed, and therefore absolute assurance that information will be secure at all times cannot be given. You acknowledge that we cannot guarantee the security of online transactions and electronic communications. We will not be held responsible for events arising from unauthorised access to personal information. If you suspect any misuse or unauthorised access to your personal information, please contact us immediately.
